Instead, the minor has been utilized almost exclusively by interior design students who have been unsuccessful in or are not interested in completing the requirements of the Bachelor of Interior Design (B.I.D.) and are pursuing unrelated degrees. Because the mission of the School of Architecture is to prepare design professionals, the minor in Interior Design is in conflict with the professional goals of the School. Elimination of the minor, effective Spring 2012, will support this mission. For other majors in the School who desire an interior design foundation, the Interior Design program will continue to encourage them to fulfill professional electives with appropriate interior design courses.
