(1) Requiring students to take both PLSC 2003 and 2013 makes sense from a pedagogical perspective. The first, 2003 focuses on the American political system, the second on comparative politics (i.e., the political systems of other countries). If a student took only the first, she would be ignorant of the rest of the world; if she took only the latter, she would be ignorant about the U.S.
(2) The requirement that students take courses from two of the five subfields is anachronistic. In the past, PLSC majors were also required to do something along similar lines. The motive for this type of requirement was to ensure that students took courses from different faculty members to get a diversity of perspectives. This requirement was imposed at a time when the department had much fewer faculty. Because we have more faculty today, and because most faculty teach both undergraduate and graduate courses, it would be much more difficult for an undergraduate student to take multiple courses from the same professor. Making the change also would give minors much more flexibility when looking for upper-division courses, many of which, are often fill quickly at registration time.
