1)When the music department instituted the requirement that all Bachelor of Music majors had to take MUEN 1411 Concert Choir in their first semester of residence (now required in the first year of residence), we failed to take into consideration the Concert Choir requirement added one more hour of large ensemble credit to the the degree. Most emphases in the Bachelor of Music degrees currently require 8 hours of large ensemble hours and Concert Choir, totaling 9 hours of ensemble. Reducing the required hours of large ensemble credit to 7 hours and one hour of Concert Choir will bring the total number of large ensemble credit hours required for the Bachelor of Music degree to a total of 8 hours. The change will agree with the original intention of our ensemble requirements.

- 2) The addition of two new ensemble courses, Wind Ensemble (MUEN 1691/2691/3691/4391/4791) and Concert Band (MUEN 1491/2491/3491/4491/4691) were created to fullfil the need of our growing enrollment in our band program. These two new courses will also be used to fulfill large ensemble requirements for the Bachelor of Music degree, Music Education, Instrumental/Woodwind/Brass/Percussion.
- 3) Enrollment in MUAC 2111 and 2121, both eight week courses, was difficult to administer since both courses needed to be taken during the same semester. We had a different group of students enrolled in first eight week session than we did in the second. The creation of the new Music Technology course, MUAC 2112, will replace the two eight week Music Technology courses, MUAC 2111/2121.
- 4) The requirement of MUPD 3811 and MUPD 38611 Conducting II is designed primarily to assist students who will be expected upon their graduation to be actively conducting as a part of their vocation: our music education students. MUPD 3801 Conducting I should be sufficient to introduce non-music education students to the fundamental conducting skills every musician should acquire.
