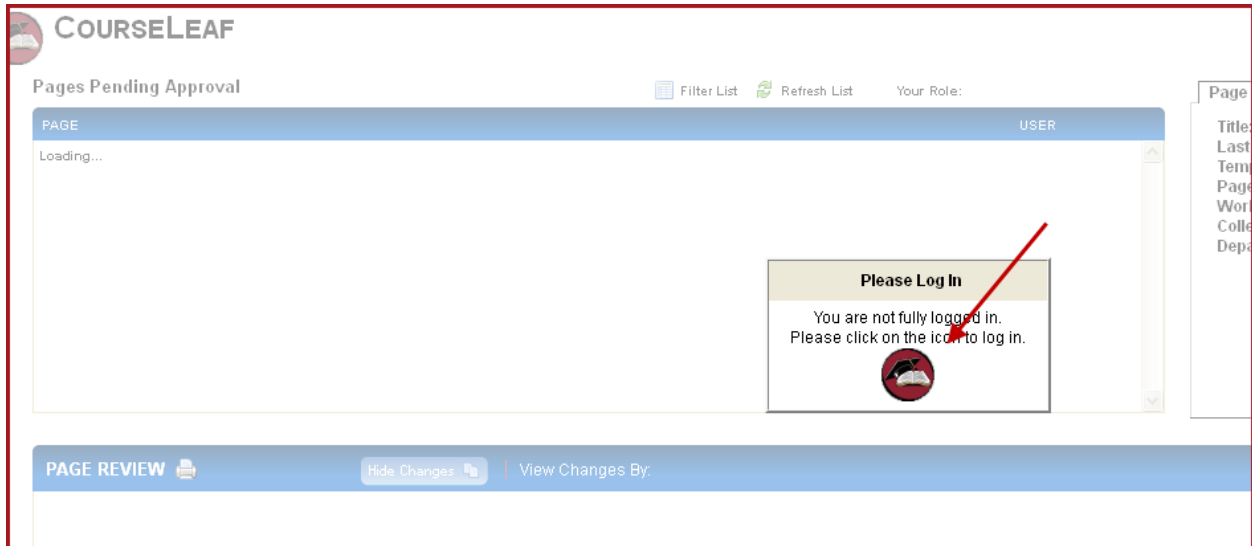
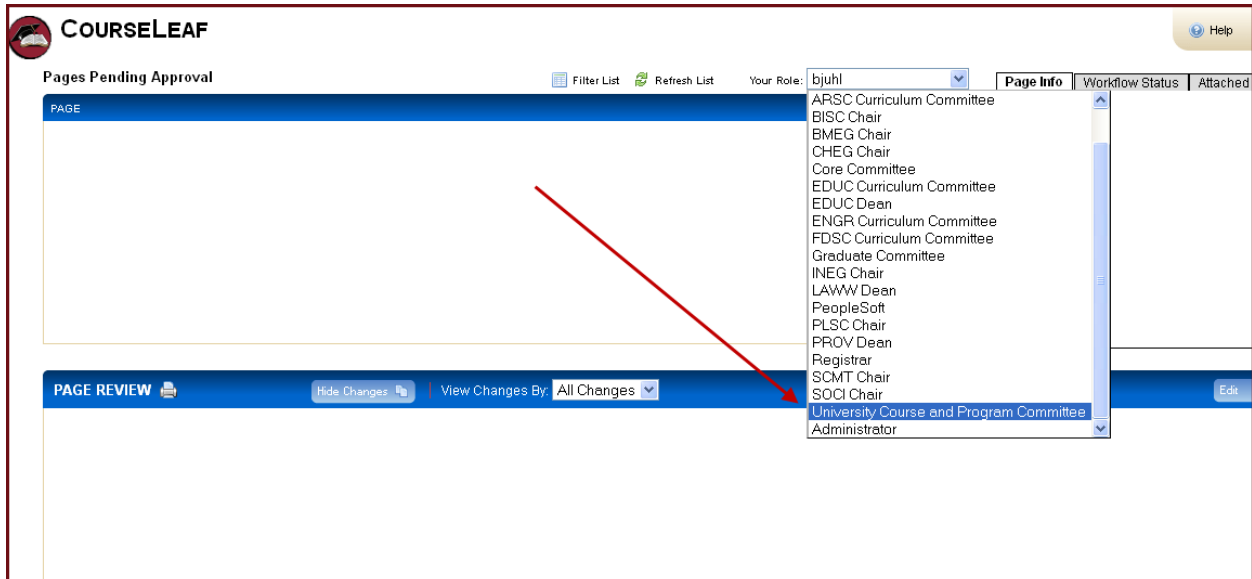


Viewing Course and Program Proposals Pending University Course and Program Committee Approval:
