This course provides an opportunity to apply principles learned in AGEC 4373 to grain merchandising using the case study approach. The course will involve in-class meetings supplemented with faculty-directed group-based learning experiences involving professional grain merchandisers. Group activities will follow the traditional case study method.
	Justification	The department is moving the course from a spring-only to fall-only offering.	The proposed change is to the number of credit hours, from a one-hour to three-hour class. The scope of the course is being expanded to cover more subject material and graded assignments commensurate with a three-credit hour course. The delivery of the course will consist of weekly lectures and supplemented with faculty-led case study assignments. The additional subject matter in the move to a three-hour course will allow students to earn a professional level 2 grain merchandising certificate, increasing their career opportunities in grain industry.

	Justification	Brief change of language from P-12 to K-12 in major (required by State Department of Education); addition of K-12 for the students coming in this fall but not eliminating the P-12; eliminating senior standing since the students are not seniors when they register for this course.	PHED 4321 has involved the placement of a student for two hours per week at a local school, generally at the elementary setting. Student feedback in recent years has indicated a lack of preparation for teaching at the secondary level. A change to 432V will change the requirement from one to two credit hours . Students would be assigned to work two hours at a secondary school and two hours at an elementary school, instead of two hours at a single school. Students under a previous catalog will only be required to register for one credit hour, but will have the option of earning two credit hours for the class if needed for elective credit.
