Description and justification of the request:	The AAST second major and minor programs are adding additional courses (PLSC/AAST 3293, ENGL/AAST 3853, and SOCI/AAST 4153) as options to satisfy the program requirements, because there are now more AAST-related courses available from a wider variety of departments. Originally, most AAST coursework came only from the history department. It is important for students to be able to select coursework from a broader set of fields.
