Admission Requirements and Procedures for the Doctor of Philosophy Degree: Applicants for the doctoral program in counselor education may obtain an application packet from the counselor education Web site: <http://cned.uark.edu>.

Doctoral applicants must:

1. Have a completed master's degree in counseling or its equivalent in areas specified by the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Education Programs (CACREP), and preferably one year post-master's professional counseling experience or the equivalent.
2. Apply to the Graduate School.
3. Submit official transcripts reflecting a minimum 3.5 GPA on all previous graduate work.
4. Submit official GRE scores indicating capacity for doctoral-level performance.
5. Submit three letters of recommendation indicating capacity for advanced graduate study.
6. Submit an autobiographical sketch.

7. **Submit a role-play recording demonstrating counseling skills.**
8. Top applicants will be invited for a formal interview with the counselor education faculty.
9. All applicants must be accepted by the Graduate School prior to consideration for admission into the Counseling Program.
10. Complete applications are due September 15 for Spring admission and January 15 for Summer/Fall admission.

Requirements for the Doctor of Philosophy Degree: Candidates for the Doctor of Philosophy in counselor education must meet the requirements for the applicable degree in the Objectives, Regulations, and Degrees section of this catalog and complete a minimum of 98 semester hours of graduate study acceptable to their doctoral advisory committee.

2. Graduates will demonstrate knowledge, skills, and practices beyond the entry-level program requirements in teaching and counselor preparation training.
3. Graduates will demonstrate knowledge, skills, and practices beyond the entry-level program requirements in research and scholarship.
4. Graduates will demonstrate knowledge, skills, and practices beyond the entry-level program requirements as advanced practitioners of counseling.
5. Graduates will demonstrate knowledge, skills, and practices beyond the entry-level program requirements in counseling leadership and advocacy.**

The proposed changes are necessary to reflect the changes in the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) accreditation standards. Additionally, the changes in the core curriculum are in response to the merger of two accrediting organizations - the Council on Rehabilitation Education (CORE) and the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP). The Plan of Merger Agreement was signed on July 20, 2015. As a result of this merger, the Ph.D. in Counselor Education program is expanding/revising its curriculum options to incorporate Rehabilitation (RHAB) courses.

Description and justification of the request:

The summary of the changes is provided below:

1. We added a role-play recording demonstrating counseling skills as an admissions requirement.
2. We removed two courses (6 credit hours) from the Counselor Education core.
3. We clarified cognate requirements and added RHAB courses as options.
4. We removed the foreign language requirement.

5. We clarified 15 credit hour research and statistics requirements by identifying courses needed to meet these requirements.
