The new title provides for a broad survey of horsemanship, behavior and the applied training techniques therein. The new name will also allow the possibility of additional classes to be added in the future (which could be named Intermediate Horsemanship, Advanced Horsemanship, etc.) as the building block for a progression of courses.
