Kinesiology K-12 Teaching Physical Education, Wellness and Leisure Concentration

A student preparing to teach in the public schools must select the K-12 teaching concentration in Kinesiology. Admission to the Kinesiology K-12 Teaching Physical Education, Wellness and Leisure Concentration requires the following:

- must be admitted to the teacher education program in kinesiology K-12 (see the <u>Teacher Education Application</u> <u>Fee</u>) after their sophomore year (45 hours of coursework).
- pass all three parts of Praxis Core according to current Arkansas State Department of Education requirements
- successfully complete an Arkansas State Police and Arkansas Child Maltreatment Registry background check (Background checks must be current, there is a fee for this process.)
- prior to taking the following pedagogical courses <u>PHED 3003</u>, <u>PHED 3033</u>, <u>PHED 3043</u>, <u>students are required</u>
 PHED 3573, <u>students are required</u> to have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above

To be eligible to enroll in senior PHED classes (<u>PHED 4703</u>, <u>PHED 4743</u>, <u>PHED 432V</u>), and the Senior Block Internship semester (<u>PHED 4023</u>, <u>PHED 407V</u>, <u>PHED 4733</u>), students are required PHED 4023, <u>PHED 407V</u>, <u>PHED 4733</u>), students are required to:

- have a cumulative grade point average of 2.7 and maintain through degree completion
- successfully complete an Arkansas State Police and Arkansas Child Maltreatment Registry background check if not completed at Stage II (Background checks must be current, there is a fee for this process.)
- complete or present proof of registration for the Praxis II exams required by the Arkansas Department of Education licensure area of K-12 Physical Education, Wellness and Leisure

In order to complete the Kinesiology K-12 Teaching Physical Education, Wellness and Leisure students must maintain a 2.7 cumulative grade point average and complete all university requirements for graduation.

Note: All students seeking licensure in the state of Arkansas are subject to a criminal background check. Forms for this procedure may be obtained at the office of the Teacher Certification Officer, at the State Department, or any police station, including the campus police. These background checks take up to six months to process; therefore, students are advised to complete and submit the forms to the proper authorities six months in advance of actually applying for a license. Arkansas will not certify anyone who has been convicted of a felony. Although not required for the Kinesiology concentration in Physical Education, Wellness and Leisure, students seeking coaching endorsement will need to take PHED 4001, take the appropriate PRAXIS exams as designated by the Arkansas State Department of Education, and make a "C" or better in all courses required by the University of Arkansas for the Coaching Endorsement. Program Goals and Objectives:

The program in kinesiology with a concentration in K-12 Teaching Physical Education, Wellness and Lesiure (KINSBS-PEWL) is designed to prepare candidates for a variety of career options teaching physical education, health, leisure and coaching in a K-12 school setting.

Learning Outcomes:

Upon completion of the Kinesiology concentration (KINSBS-PEWL), students will be eligible to be recommended for licensure by the Arkansas State Department of Education to teach physical education, wellness (health education) and leisure (recreational activities) in public and private school kindergarten through twelfth grade settings.

Description and justification of the request:

The pedagogy faculty has voted to move The School Health Program (PHED 3573) class from the listing of pedagogical classes as part of the admission process into teacher education into the listing of regularly required courses for the degree program. The pedagogy class listing are classes that are gate checked with a certain grade point average, passing of the Praxis Core (all three parts) and PHED 1003 as prerequisites. The PHED faculty feel It is important to have enough upper division classes that are not a part of the admission process available for students; particularly transfer students and those students that may just be barely below the standard of admission to teacher education and need another semester to complete that process. The prerequisite for this class; The School Health Program (PHED 3573) is PBHL 1103 (Personal Health and Safety). It always has been the prerequisite and did not change when we inadvertently put the classes in the list of pedagogical class. This does not change the program in any way as to classes required or required hours for the degree. It is just placing the class in a different category in the curriculum.
