Program Goals and Objectives: Graduates are prepared to function independently or in a collaborative role on an interdisciplinary team as change agents to affect nursing education.

Learning Outcomes: The Nurse Educator Core and specialty development courses prepare Nurse Educator students to assume roles in various educational settings. The Thesis or Research Project allows students to contribute to new knowledge in nursing through original research, replication studies, dissemination efforts, and utilization projects. The thesis or scholarly project requirement also prepares graduates for further study in a doctoral program.

Description and justification of the request: Courses are being added and deleted from the list of requirements. Concentration changes were made to align the Nurse Educator concentration with the Nurse Executive Leader concentration and decrease unnecessary concentration redundancies.
