Admission Requirements for the Master of Education in Special Education:

A bachelor's degree from an accredited institution of higher education

A minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) during the last 60 hours of undergraduate work

Praxis Core Exam or other approved Standardized Core Knowledge Test GRE minimum scores for Verbal and Quantitative Reasoning at the 49th percentile and at the 54th percentile for Analytical Writing

Requirements for the Master of Education in Special Education: (Minimum of 36 graduate hours.) All programs will require nine semester hours of core courses, three semester hours of cognate study, and 24 semester hours in special education.
