We value communication skills, leadership experience, initiative, community service, and clinical experience, as well as accomplishments in athletics, employment, and research. Our goal is to recruit and educate a class which will serve the needs of a diverse population.

We consider factors not reflected in the academic record, such as evidence of extracurricular achievement or work experience; evidence of having overcome social, economic, or physical barriers; evidence of exceptional motivation, maturity, or responsibility.

Conditional admission will be determined by the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing's holistic admission committee. To be eligible to apply, students must have a cumulative GPA of \geq 3.0.

The holistic admission process for the professional program of study is as follows:

Application to the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing completed. Please refer to current dates for the application window that can be located on our website. Please note that students need to apply almost a full year in advance of when they plan to start.

Students transferring from another nursing program must provide a letter from the nursing program indicating that they are eligible to return and are in good standing to be considered for admission. Final transcripts will need to be submitted for any non-University of Arkansas coursework by the end of the application semester. (official dates on website)

Upon review of these transcripts, the holistic admission committee will review the following:
