In addition to the requirements of the Graduate **School and those established** ~~School, the following requirements have been established~~ by the College of Engineering for all doctoral **graduates, the following**

requirements have been established for INEG doctoral graduates:

A minimum of 72 semester hours of graduate-level credit beyond the bachelor’s degree.

A minimum of 42 semester hours of graduate-level credit beyond the master’s **degree of which a minimum of 21 semester hours shall be approved graduate level courses and a minimum of 21 semester hours of dissertation hours (INEG 700V).** ~~degree.~~

Students admitted with a BS degree must complete their initial 30 semester hours out of the 72 total at the 5000 level or above, with the remaining 42 semester hours subject to the rule stated in paragraph 2 above.

INEG PhD students pass a Qualifier Exam over a subset of topics in Industrial Engineering determined by the student’s Doctoral Advisory Committee. Students may fail the exam once and retake it. Students who fail the exam twice will be dismissed from the PhD program.
