- Add ISYS 1123, Business Application Knowledge to first year, fall semester, 8 semester plan
- Delete ISYS 1120, Computer Competency Requirement from first year, fall semester, 8 semester plan
- Delete 3 hours of general education elective from fourth year, spring semester, 8 semester plan
- Add US History or Political Science University Core to fourth year, spring semester, 8 semester plan

#### Justification for this change

Pre-assessment exam scores for incoming freshmen over the past several years have been consistently indicating that only 4% of incoming freshmen have sufficient IT competency (coming out of their High School program) for Walton College courses. Therefore, most incoming Walton freshmen are required to take ISYS 1123, Business Application Knowledge in lieu of ISYS 1120, Computer Competency Requirement which currently does not count toward their degree. This change deletes ISYS 1120 as a prebusiness requirement and incorporates ISYS 1123 as a pre-business and degree requirement. Additionally, reducing the total number of General Education Electives from 12 hours to 9 hours.
