Description and justification of the request

Description of specific change Justification for this change Pre-assessment exam scores for incoming - Add ISYS 1123, Business Application Knowledge to first freshmen over the past several years have been year, fall semester, 8 semester plan consistently indicating that only 4% of incoming - Delete ISYS 1120, Computer Competency Requirement freshmen have sufficient IT competency (coming from first year, fall semester, 8 semester plan out of their High School program) for Walton - Delete 3 hours of general education elective from third College courses. Therefore, most incoming year, spring semester, 8 semester plan Walton freshmen are required to take ISYS 1123, - Add US History or Political Science - University Core to Business Application Knowledge in lieu of ISYS third year, spring semester, 8 semester plan 1120, Computer Competency Requirement which currently does not count toward their degree. This change deletes ISYS 1120 as a prebusiness requirement and incorporates ISYS 1123 as a pre-business and degree requirement. Additionally, reducing the total number of General Education Electives from 12 hours to 9 hours.
