Title MicroCertificates: Creation of Graduate and Undergraduate MicroCertificates

Several University constituents feel that this type of credential would enhance our port students. Micro-certificates (Non-degree) Graduate micro-certificates: As defined by the graduate-level micro-certificate programs consist of six to nine hours of required coursework in a specific area. The awarding of the micro-certificates will be shown on the student's transcript. Admission requirements of the Graduate School and the micro-certificate program. The program will not impose a limit on the number of hours that may be shared between micro-certificates and graduate certificate or degree programs, but a limit may be set by the program. Students in the micro-certificate program must complete all requirements within six years of admission to the University. Students who have been admitted to both a graduate degree program and a micro-certificate program may also be used to meet the requirements of the other program and the student's Advisory Committee. Coursework may not be transferred from

meet the requirements of a micro-certificate. Micro-certificates must meet, at a minimum average requirements of the Graduate School although programs may have higher star micro-certificates: As defined by the University of Arkansas, undergraduate-level micro consist of nine to 15 hours of required course work in a specialized area. The awarding will be shown on the student's transcript. Students must meet the admissions and graduation requirements of the University of Arkansas. Credits earned toward the micro-certificate may also be used toward the requirements of an undergraduate degree. Transfer work from another university will not meet the requirements of a microcredential.
