## Program Requirements and Description

### Requirements

**Prerequisites to Degree Programs:** Applicants for the M.Ed. degree must have completed a bachelor's degree and earned a 3.00 GPA on the last 60 hours of undergraduate course. Applicants with an earned GPA of 2.7-2.9 on the last 60 hours of undergraduate course work may be considered if an acceptable score on the Graduate Record Examination or Miller Analogies Test is obtained.

**Requirements for the Master of Education Degree:** In addition to the general requirements of the Graduate School, students must complete a minimum of **31** ~~30~~ hours of graduate course work to include **22** ~~21~~ semester hours of core educational technology courses and 9 semester hours of elective curriculum and instruction or educational technology courses. Additionally, a Culminating Student Portfolio must be successfully completed in the last semester of course work and will replace the Graduate School requirement of a comprehensive examination.

Educational Technology Core: **22** ~~21~~ hours

Educations Technology Electives: 9 hours
