Admission to the M.Ed. Programs: Admission In addition to meeting university requirements for admission to the Master of Education (M.Ed.) in Educational Leadership requires prior admission to the University of Arkansas Graduate School School, all candidates seeking admission to any educational leadership program must complete program application procedures, which are described on the program website. In addition, admission to the M.Ed. in Educational Leadership requires the following: a complete Educational Leadership program application; a valid teaching license; GRE or MAT when cumulative GPA or GPA on the last 60 hours of coursework is less than 3.00; Leadership Disposition Survey; statement of purpose; and three letters of recommendation (one of which should be from a current employer). Interview with EDLE faculty or program coordinator may be requested. Admissions for the Master's degree are rolling; therefore, prospective students can apply at any time of the year. Application for admission must be completed before the required deadlines for each semester as set by the Graduate School.

Requirements for the Master of Education (M.Ed.) Degree (33 hours): The master's degree in Educational Leadership is designed primarily to provide professional preparation for students seeking administrative positions in elementary and secondary schools. It requires the following:
