Multiple institutions in the surrounding region offer a master in public health degree, but only one offers a concentration in public health physical activity - Kansas State University.

Why is the Program

needed if offered at

other institutions?

Overall employment of public health workers is projected to grow 11 percent from 2018 to 2028, much faster than the average for all occupations. Growth will be driven by efforts to improve health outcomes and to reduce healthcare costs by teaching people healthy behaviors and explaining how to use available healthcare services. As Arkansas ranks at or near last nationwide in most health outcomes, an emphasis on public health is needed. Since 1996, there has been a 300% increase in accredited schools and programs of

3

public health nationwide, and the University of Arkansas is one of but a very few land grant institutions that does not offer the MPH degree. In fact, most States have MPH degrees at multiple Colleges and Universities within their State.

The current M.S. in Community Health promotion is outdated and has been supplanted by the MPH degree, which is a professional degree and the recognized degree in the field of community and public health. With the increase in demand for public health workers, the U.S. has seen an increase in the number and diversity of public health graduates. In 2018, 47% of public health graduates were minority and 70% were female, with a nearly 6 times increase in graduates since 1975.
