Admission to the Pre-Licensure B.S.N. Program

Students interested in nursing will be admitted to the traditional, on campus pre-licensure BSN program must be admitted to the University of Arkansas as pre-nursing (P-NURS/Health) majors. Admission to the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing requires as exparate an application in addition to the application to the University of Arkansas. In line with initiatives of the university and the College of Education and Health Professions, as well as the philosophy of the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing, a holistic admission process is utilized to enhance a diverse academic experience for all students and results in additional expertise in providing care to an increasingly diverse patient population.

Admission is competitive, not all applicants who meet the minimum requirements will be admitted to theprogram. We value communication skills, leadership experience, initiative, community service, and clinical experience, as well as accomplishments in athletics, employment, andresearch. The school's goal is to recruit and educate a class which will serve the needs of a diversepopulation. We consider factors not reflected in the academic record, such as evidence of extracurricular achievement or work experience; evidence of having overcome social, economic, or physical barriers; evidence of exceptional motivation, maturity, orresponsibility. Admission Conditional admission will be determined by the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing's faculty. faculty. To be eligible to apply, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or more. To be eligible to apply, students must be admitted to the University of Arkansas, be Students transferring from another nursing program must provide a pre-nursing/health major, submit a complete application package on or before the deadline, have a cumulative GPA of 3. letter from the nursing program indicating that they are eligible to return and are in good standing to be considered for admission. 5 or more, score a 70 or higher on the ATI TEAS entrance exam, complete the Casper Situational Judgment Test, and have completed a background check. Background checks are governed by AR Code § 17-87-312 (2020) (or any future version). An individual is not eligible to receive or hold a license issued by a licensing entity if that individual has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been found guilty of any of the offenses outlined in AR Code § 17-3-102 (2020) (or any future version), thus they will not be eligible to apply for the nursing major(s).
