The goal of the online BSE in Educational Studies for Para-professionals program is to provide working para-professionals with an associate's degree a path towards bachelors' degree completion as a necessary requirement to earn their Arkansas teaching license. The State of Arkansas <u>and most states require</u> requires an accredited bachelor's degree for all public <u>K-12</u> pK-12 teachers.
