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The Anthropology Department at the University of Arkansas presently offers two degree\ \nprograms to undergraduate students—the BA (Bachelor of Arts), and the BS (Bachelor of \\nScience). The Department of Anthropology at the University of Arkansas comprises three\ \nseparate disciplines – Cultural Anthropology, Biological Anthropology, and Archeology.\ \nThe Department offers introductory courses in each subdiscipline, as well as a capstone \\ncourse required for all anthropology majors. In order to bring the Department's\ \nassessment program in line with the College requirements, and in order to standardize\ \nassessment as much as possible across courses, the Anthropology Department revised \\nits Assessment Plan in the Spring of 2020. This stands as the current assessment plan, \\nincluding revision of student learning outcomes, re-evaluating the tools used for\ \nassessment, and instituting a formal plan for Departmental Program Assessment.
