The Undergraduate Curriculum Committee of History investigated the practice of benchmark institutions concerning the level of AP credit accepted. The Committee found that an overwhelming number of its peer institutions set 4 as a minimum score for AP credit. Additionally, one historian served as a grader for AP exams in U.S. History this summer--he found the level of 3 to be unsatisfactory in terms of content and level of sophistication. Therefore, HIST is bringing its system of evaluating AP exams in line with the best practice of the profession.
