The University of Arkansas no longer has a Middle Level Program, leaving only a P-4 or 7-12 initial licensure option for teacher candidates. There is a great need in Arkansas for teachers who are highly qualified and certified to teach grades 5 and 6. The U of A does have an additional licensure program, or endorsement, in grades 5 and 6 only that can be added to a standard teaching area in grades P-4. The courses for this program currently exist and are approved by the Arkansas Department of Education as an Additional Licensure Program of Study. This modification does not require new courses, new faculty, or resources. The Childhood Education faculty unanimously approved this change at their September 21, 2011 meeting.
