It is a proposal-driven major in which students must develop a set of courses which will encourage the student to explore and make connections between two or more areas in sufficient depth and breadth to prepare them for employment or graduate/professional study. There are two options available for students wishing to pursue a B.A. in Interdisciplinary Studies.

Option1: Construction of an Interdisciplinary Studies major consisting of three thematically linked minors from within the Fulbright College of Arts and Sciences

Option 2: Construction of an Interdisciplinary Studies major consisting of a thematically linked set of coursework without the required minors framework.
