A change from the Department of Drama to the Department of Theatre is a more accurate representation of the academic and production work completed on this campus. A Department of Theatre typically represents a program that produces theatre and offers the Master of Fine Arts terminal degree, whereas, a Department of Drama historically has had an active scholarly component such as Master of Arts and/or Ph.D. program in Drama. Since the University of Arkansas has not offered the Master of Arts degree since the mid-1990's and has been offering the B.A. and M.F.A. for over 20 years, the change to Department of Theatre is the industry standard whereas the Department of Drama is an anomaly. As a result, the name of the minor in Drama needs to be changed to reflect the departmental name change.
