This is a minor change impacting less than half the program requirements. The changes are being made are in response to the Arkansas Department of Education's changes in teacher licensure from a PreKindergarten-4th grade license to Kindergarten-6th grade license. In making the changes, program faculty consulted ADE's required course competencies, the content addressed in the new Praxis exams students must pass to obtain licensure, various national standards documents, and the Common Core State Standards. The Reading option was added to focus on the current climate of increasing the body of knowledge regarding literacy education in the elementary schools and the focus in the Common Core State Standards on literacy in all content areas including, but not limited to, English Language Arts. The Gifted and Talented option was created to address this area of teacher shortage across the state of Arkansas. Grades 5 and 6 Endorsement is no longer needed with the change in elementary licensure to include these grades. Special Education is no longer needed due to the addition of a Special Education licensure bachelors degree at UofA and other institutions across the state. The exact changes were detailed above in Section V and below in Section VII.

The University of Arkansas offers the Bachelor of Science (B.S.E.) degree in Childhood Elementary Education and the Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) degree in Childhood Elementary Education. These combined degree programs are one of the options at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, that lead to initial teacher licensure in Childhood Elementary Education (Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 4 Kindergarten through Grade 6). Students who obtain their B.S.E. degree from the University of Arkansas will have completed the prerequisite course requirements for entry into the M.A.T. program. Students who obtain a bachelors degree from another university and/or in a program area other than Elementary Education must have their transcripts evaluated by an Childhood Elementary Education program adviser to determine what deficiencies must be met before they can be considered for admission into the M.A.T. program. The M.A.T. degree program is a 33-semester-hour program. To be recommended for licensure by the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, campus, students must complete the M.A.T. degree program or the undergraduate Elementary Licensure program (see undergraduate catalog for more information). Students also choose either a sub-specialty area of special education or English as a second language, Gifted and Talented, Reading, or grades 5/6 endorsement for P-4 candidates, or STEM education. A graduate certificate in STEM Education for Early Childhood (K-4 6) is also available.

### Prerequisites to Degree Program

Enrollments will be limited in upper division professional studies courses in the Childhood Elementary Education B.S.E. Program. In addition, the number of students accepted into the M.A.T. Program in Childhood Elementary Education will be contingent upon availability of placements with partnership schools. Specific application procedures, screening, and selection criteria are in effect to limit course enrollments and acceptance to the M.A.T. program. Please contact your childhood Elementary education program faculty adviser for details regarding the selective admission process. Admission requirements for the M.A.T. degree program for initial certification are as follows:

- 1. Completion of an appropriate undergraduate degree program.
- 2. Cumulative GPA of 3.00, or 3.00 in the last 60 hours of the baccalaureate degree.
- 3. Admission to the Graduate School, including the requisite score on the GRE.
- 4. Screening/acceptance into internship, which includes an admission portfolio a successful teaching audition and letters of recommendation.
- 5. Admission to the Master of Arts in Teaching program.
- 6. Successful completion of the required criminal background check. Background check materials must be submitted by May 1st prior to the internship year. Maintain a current background check.
- 7. Completion of the pre-education core with a minimum of "C" in all courses.
- 8. Completion of all prerequisite courses in teaching field.
- 9. Payment of internship fee.
