Health policy involves skills such as understanding agenda setting, alternative specification, and policy formulation. Specific issue areas that may be of interest to the student include: Medicaid/Medicare, manager care organizations, the health care delivery system, and health care inflation. The study of public policy and health will prepare the student for positions in government at the local, state and federal level. Various health care agencies such as the World Health Organization (WHO), the Red Cross, and UNICEF will also be interested in students who have received this degree.~~

Course of Study (12 Hours)

This concentration requires twelve hours of post masters studies. The following two courses must be taken by all Ph.D. students in order to satisfy the requirements of the concentration:

HLSC 699V--Seminar: Law and Policy Governing Health Care Delivery Systems

HLSC 5633--Health Planning

The following courses, or their equivalents, must be taken. However, if any of these courses, or their equivalent, have been taken during the master's program, electives will be selected to comprise the remaining six concentration hours needed for the Ph.D in Policy:

HLSC 5613--Principles of Epidemiology

HLSC 5633--Health Services Administration OR HLSC 5563--Public Health
