Dear Paul,

One of our apparel courses, AMPD 2033 Computer Based Methods for Apparel requires an entry level computer course as a prerequisite to the class. AGME 2903 is currently listed as the pre-requisite, but as our student enrollments have increased it has become more difficult for all students to access AGME 2903 in a timely manner. Many students have enrolled in ISYS 1123, which we have identified as a reasonable introductory computer class for the apparel course, but since the ISIS system does not recognize "or equivalent" this creates a paperwork flow to override the student into the course. **With your approval, we would like to add ISYS 1123 as one of the courses that would be acceptable as a pre-requisite to AMPD 2033 in addition to AGME 2903.**
