The program change for the minor in HDFS, presented for 2017-2018, will consist of the following:

1. ADDED HESC 2433 Child Development to the list of required courses (and DELETED from "Choose from" list)
2. CHANGED the prefix of both RSOC 2603 and 4603 to HESC to bring the check sheet up to date
3. CHANGED the total number of required credits to 9, to reflect the addition of Child Development.
4. CHANGED the total number of credits from "Choose From" courses from 12 to 9, due to deletion of Child Development.
5. CHANGED the title of "Rural Sociology" to "Rural Families and Communities" to bring the check sheet up to date
6. CHANGED the course number of Family Financial Management from 4753 to 2483, to bring the check sheet up to date
7. CHANGED the course number of Parent/Family Dynamics from 4453 to 3453, to bring the check sheet up to date
8. CHANGED the course number of Child Guidance and lab from 3402/3401L to 2473/2471L, to bring the check sheet up to date.
9. ADDED the course HESC 4233 Childhood Obesity: Context and Prevention to the list of "Choose from" courses.
10. ADDED the course HESC 4313 Building Family and Community Relationships to the list of "Choose from" courses.
11. ADDED the course HESC 4413 Infancy: Brain, Learning and Social Cognition to the list of "Choose from" courses.
12. ADDED the course HESC 4473 Multicultural Families to the list of "Choose from" courses
13. DELETED the course HESC 4463 Administration and Leadership in the Helping Professions from the list of "Choose from" courses.

Description and
justification of the
request:

The addition of Child Development to the required courses list reflects agreement among the HDFS faculty that Child Development is central to knowledge of Human Development and Family Sciences. Additionally, it was previously a de-facto requirement, because it is a pre-requisite for many courses in the “choose from” list.

The change of the total required credit hours from 6 to 9 and of “Choose from” credits from 12 to 9 accurately reflects the new requirements for the minor.

The name change of Rural Sociology to Rural Families and Communities more accurately reflects the primary focus of the class material.

The addition of the courses on A. Multicultural Families, B. Infancy, C. Building Family and Community Relationships, and D. Childhood Obesity to the “choose from” list brings the minor check sheet up to date with current course offerings.

The change in the level for Parenting and Family Dynamics and Family Financial Management reflects a change already in the system.

The change in the level for Child Guidance reflects a change already fully in effect.

The removal of the course HESC 4463 Administration and Leadership in the Helping Professions from the list of “Choose from” courses reflects a feeling on the part of the faculty that this course is more suited to majors, who will have more complete knowledge of HDFS material. In addition, the course includes specific content best suited to majors.
