Reason for deletion: The current degree program consists of one major with three concentrations (Birth through Kindergarten, Child Development, and Lifespan). Because the course requirements for teacher licensure are extensive, the concentration became too differentiated from the other concentrations to comply with policy about credit hour limits for concentrations. For that reason, the major is being reconfigured to offer two majors (Birth through Kindergarten and Human Development and Family Sciences).
