Interior Design Honors Program The Fay Jones School's Interior Design Honors Program provides upper-level undergraduate students with an opportunity to formally participate in creative and scholarly activities in interior design. Delete To this end, the department faculty has developed the Department of Interior Design Honors program

Program that is part of the University of Arkansas Honors College. Honors candidates engage in independent study and research and enroll in special honors seminars and colloquia. These learning opportunities are led by the interior design faculty and are tailored to meet students' unique interests and professional trends. Students should begin to think about research topics early in their program and select their topic by the end of their second year. The department requires each honors student to: maintain minimum cumulative grade-point average of 3.5 in all college course work, take 12 hours in honors studies, enroll in honors colloquia when available, enroll in and complete six hours of approved honors research, and complete and defend an honors thesis. Each honors student will be required to select an honors committee. The committee will be composed of the honors thesis advisor (a faculty member in the Interior Design program and principal instructor in the area of the honors project), a second faculty member from interior design, architecture, or landscape architecture

program chosen by the student, and a member from outside the department or school, selected by the thesis adviser and student. This committee is responsible for monitoring the work of the student in the area of the honors project and will administer the oral examination to the candidate at the end of the final semester of the student's program. The committee then recommends the student receive honors in interior design. Students in the Interior Design Honors Program are eligible to graduate cum laude, magna cum laude, and summa cum laude.
