The word, Innovation is too broad and difficult to define; therefore, it is being replaced by the word Management. Management better describes what the hospitality program is teaching. This change is encouraged and supported by both the hospitality students, nutrition and dietetics students, and both the NUTR and HOSP Board of Advisors.
