Description and justification of the request

Description of specific change	Justification for this change
A change in the Bachelor of Arts in Art degree program is being proposed through this reconfiguration request. The current curriculum includes a major in Art with concentrations in Studio Art and Art History. In recent years, the curriculum in each concentration has been extensively modified to bring them up to date with contemporary needs as well as peer institution precedent. Very little overlap remains in core courses between Studio Art and Art History and faculty agree that each concentration should become a stand-alone major within the Bachelor of Arts degree program.	The proximity and close cooperative relationship the Art Department has with the world renown Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art, as well as a recently approved name change for the department to become the School of Art, makes the separation of the Art History and Studio Art programs into stand-alone majors more in line with our specific needs and peer institution norms. The addition of faculty in the Art History area, as well as significant increases in the number of students majoring in and graduating with the concentration of Art History, create a climate that requires a stand-alone major in the area as opposed to a concentration within a more generalized major.
Removed primary/secondary media tracks, removed Professional Practices requirement, removed redundant non-art courses requirement, and added Media Categories.	Updated old program requirements to better align with the new major.
