In addition to the general requirements for the AFLSPH listed above, students Students in the the Horticulture concentration Concentration must complete 9 graduate-level take at least three graduate course credits of courses in Horticulture (HORT). each of the participating departments (horticulture and plant pathology), at least six elective graduate credits outside of the program in an area appropriate to their dissertation research, two semesters (2 credits) in PTSC 6101 Colloquium in Plant Sciences, one in each department, and students are required to present at least four seminars (while enrolled for credit in HORT 5001 Seminar) to include the following:

a research proposal seminar, two topic seminars on subjects other than their research area and an exit seminar describing the results of their dissertation research. All students will be expected to complete 18 hours of dissertation research.
