#### Requirements

**Requirements for Departmental Honors in History:** Both the College and the Departmental Honors Program in History provide undergraduates with an opportunity to carry out independent study and research under the guidance of history faculty and to participate in special honors **courses**, <del>classes</del>, seminars, and colloquia. Admission to the Fulbright Honors Program is open to history majors with a **minimum** minimum, cumulative **GPA** grade-point average of 3.5 in all of their **courses**. <del>coursework.</del> Honors candidates must complete a minimum of 12 **credit** hours in honors courses, including <u>HIST 3973H</u> and at least 3 but no more than 6 **credit** hours of <u>HIST 399VH</u>. College **Honors** honors students majoring in history must also complete either

## <u>HIST 1113H</u> or <u>HUMN 1114H</u>, and either <u>HIST 1123H</u> or <u>HUMN 2114H</u>. Also, honors candidates must complete a world language at the Intermediate II (2013) level or higher.

To complete the required thesis, honors candidates should choose a faculty thesis director as early as possible but no later than the first semester of the student's junior year. Honors candidates must meet the college's requirements for an honors degree. Students graduating with honors typically graduate with the distinction *cum laude*. Higher distinctions (*summa cum magna cum laude*, *magna cum summa cum laude*) are awarded by the Honors Council in truly exceptional **cases** case and are based upon the whole of the candidate's program of honors studies.
