Obtain passing scores on the *Core Academic Skills for Educator: Math, Reading, and Writing* sections of the Praxis Core Exam.

Students who do not meet admission criteria for the **B.S. B.S.E.**-degree program in communication **sciences and** disorders in any given year may reapply in subsequent years.
