No additional instructional costs will be incurred for the Online Minor in Accounting. The courses required for the Online Minor in Accounting are

already being offered for the Online BSBA in General Business, the Online BSBA in Accounting. The on-line sections are also available as options for the on-campus degree-seeking students, as allowed under University requirements. Future direct costs over the course of the next three years will include the costs to refresh the online courses (approximately 9 courses over the next 3 years at \$4,000 per course = \$36,000). Costs will be paid for by the revenue generated from the Online BSBA in Accounting.
