Our goal with the Arabic minor is to better prepare our students to compete in a global environment and expand their employment opportunities in the national and international job market; to respond to growing student demand for basic, intermediate and advanced instruction in Arabic; to provide an incentive to extend their study of Arabic beyond the basic language sequence into upper-level courses; and to better exploit opportunities and increase student participation in the University of Arkansas's Middle East Studies program.
