The EMSON Post-Graduate Certificate program empowers advanced practice nursing professionals to advance their careers and pursue board certification in one of two Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) specializations: Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP), Adult Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner (AG-ACNP).

Adult Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner (AG-ACNP)

21 minimum credits | 495 clinical hours

Students complete this post-doctoral/post-master's certificate program on a part-time basis. Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in the United States or the equivalent from an international college or university, maintain a current registered nurse (RN) license, and have earned either (1) a Master of Science degree in Nursing 1 from a CCNE- or ACEN-accredited program, or (2) a doctoral degree (DNAP, DNP, or PhD) to be eligible for consideration. Other requirements include:

Evidence of at least two years of strong professional nursing experience.

Evidence of clinical placement commitments (necessary to fulfill the clinical objectives of the certificate) for master's or DNP prepared nurse practitioners.

Evidence of national certification in advanced practice nursing specialty.

Evidence of NP licensure.

Students who pursue this specialization will learn how to effectively communicate with families and manage multifaceted acute care situations.

- 12. Develop, implement, and evaluate educational interventions for patients, families and staff.
- 13. Through collaboration with the inter-professional team, develop a comprehensive plan of care to include a comprehensive history and physical, problem list, education plan, and referral follow-up process to determine outcomes of evidence-based care for adult and geriatric populations with complex acute and critical health problems.
- 14. Utilize evidence-based practices, products, and technology that are specific to adult-geriatric populations into clinical practice and utilize specialty-based technical skills in the performance of therapeutic and diagnostic procedures.
- 15. Use evidence-based criteria to evaluate client outcomes and modify existing plans of care through synthesis of previous data derived from on-going assessment of client information.
- 16. Plan appropriate diagnostic and therapeutic interventions with concern for safety, cost, invasiveness, acceptability, simplicity and effectiveness.
- 17. Evaluate legal and ethical principles to guide decision-making in the advanced nursing practice role.
