Students admitted to the Integrated Master of Accountancy program (IMACC) who plan continuous enrollment into the M.Acc. program do not need to reapply but must submit an acceptable GMAT score. Students applying to any other Walton master's degree* may be eligible for a GMAT or GRE waiver under the following conditions:

Student has earned a 3.2 cumulative or last 60 credit hour GPA from an accredited US institution (undergraduate or graduate degree)

OR the student has a minimum of 3 years of relevant professional work experience as evaluated by the program admissions committee

Exceptions may be made for other outstanding achievements or qualifications – (eg: JD/MD/PHD, or valid alternate exam as determined by the admissions committee)

All international applicants with only international academic transcripts must submit a valid GMAT or GRE exam as part of their complete application packet.

If the GMAT/GRE waiver is denied as part of an initial program review, students must submit a valid GMAT or GRE exam (depending on specific program requirements) for further admission consideration.

*All Walton doctoral programs require either a valid GMAT or GRE for admission.
