Conditional Admission to the Pre-Licensure B.S.N. Program

Students interested in nursing will be admitted to the University of Arkansas as pre-nursing majors. Admission to the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing requires an application in addition to the application to the University of Arkansas. In line with initiatives of the university and the College of Education and Health Professions, as well as the philosophy of the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing, a this holistic admission process is utilized to enhance a a diverse academic experience for all students and results in additional expertise in providing care to an

increasingly diverse patient population. Admission is competitive, not all applicants who meet the minimum requirements will be admitted to the program.

We value communication skills, leadership experience, initiative, community service, and clinical experience, as well as accomplishments in athletics, employment, and research. The school's goal is to recruit and educate a class which will serve the needs of a diverse population.

We consider factors not reflected in the academic record, such as evidence of extracurricular achievement or work experience; evidence of having overcome social, economic, or physical barriers; evidence of exceptional motivation, maturity, or responsibility.

Conditional admission will be determined by the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing's **faculty**. holistic admission committee. To be eligible to apply, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or more.

The holistic admission process for the professional program of study is as follows:

Application to the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing completed. Please refer to current dates for the application window that can be located on our website. Please note that students need to apply almost a full year in advance of when they plan to start.

Students transferring from another nursing program must provide a letter from the nursing program indicating that they are eligible to return and are in good standing to be considered for admission.

Final transcripts will need to be submitted for any non-University of Arkansas coursework by the end of the application semester. (official dates on website)

Upon review of these transcripts, **EMSON faculty** the holistic admission committee will review the following: Stagel:Primary Academic Factors (50% of total score)
