Justification for this request

Increasingly, the students interested in this minor are coming from the Fay Jones School of Architecture -- where it should be administered, not in ARSC. Also, since the co-creator of the minor, Tom Green (ANTH), is long retired, the minor has created an unwarranted burden on the remaining co-creator with advising, substitution justifications, and offering the capstone course (GEOS 3033) as a directed readings course to ~1 student each year.
