Requirements

Requirements for Departmental Honors in History: The Both the College and the Departmental Honors Programs Program in History provide undergraduates with an opportunity to carry out independent study and research under the guidance of history faculty and to participate in special honors courses, seminars, and colloquia. Admission to the Fulbright Honors Program is open to history majors with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 in all of their courses. Honors candidates must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours in honors courses, including HIST 3973H and at least 3 but no more than 6 credit hours of HIST 399VH. Fulbright College honors students majoring in history must also complete either HIST 1113H or HUMN 1114H, and either HIST 1123H or HUMN 2114H. Also, honors candidates must complete a world language at the Intermediate II (2013) level orhigher. Candidates for <u>Departmental Honors in History must</u> To complete a minimum of 12 credit hours in the required thesis, honors courses, including at least three hours chosen from HIST 3973H, HIST 4893H, or HIST 498VH. To complete the required thesis, honors candidates should choose a a faculty thesis director as early as possible but no later than the first semester of of the student's junior year. Honors candidates must meet the college's requirements for an honors degree. degree. Students graduating with honors typically graduate with the distinction distinction distinction laude. Higher distinctions (summa cum summa cum laude, magna cum, magna cum laude) are awarded by the Honors Council in truly exceptional cases and are based upon the whole of the candidate's program of honors studies.
